


# Koroit and District Primary School 9th May 2025

#### **Education Week and Open Sessions**

#### Walk to School Friday 16th May

National Walk Safely to School Day is an annual event in Australia that encourages primary school children to walk to school. It promotes road safety, healthy habits, and environmental awareness. This year, it takes place on Friday, May 16th, 2025. Koroit and District students are encouraged to join staff at the Green (where the spud picker is) and at the gardens. Children and staff will walk to school together.

#### Personal Development for Grade 3-6

All grade 3-6 children will take part in Personal Development sessions with Leanne O'Connor on Friday 23rd May.

Leanne O'Connor is a Registered Nurse/Midwife and will once again facilitate these sessions.

Leanne educates the children in line with current Victorian Curriculum requirements. Leanne uses resources guided by Victorian Department of Education and Training's framework.

Year 4 students will receive 2 1/2 hours of education. They will be split into gender groups for 30 minutes. Year 3 students will receive a 1-hour sessions

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. Means-tested concession cards must be valid on the first day of Term 1, 2025 (Tuesday 28 January 2025) or Term 2, 2025 (Tuesday 22 April 2025).

A student aged 16 years and over who is considered a mature minor and holds a valid concession card is also eligible to apply.

Eligible families will receive a payment of \$154 per year for primary school students and \$256 per year for secondary school students. The funds will be paid directly to the school to be used towards camps, sports and excursion costs for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time, please contact the school office on 0355 658332 and ask for an application form. Please return completed application forms to the school office as soon as possible.


