

Evacuation Drill

On Tuesday of this week, our whole school participated in an off-site Evacuation Drill. The drill was a 'threat' based at Ag Warehouse . All staff & students exited the KDPS school grounds via the oval and gathered at Victoria park for a roll call.

Practicing emergency response procedures through drills: promotes more effective emergency response procedures, by ensuring that evacuation locations and pathways are practical and workable in different emergency scenarios and that safety will be maintained throughout the response procedure.





















